

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Booth display should not exceed boundaries. Any exhibitor needing additional space will be expected to reserve two (or more as needed) spaces. All electrical and wiring must be totally contained within the exhibitors assigned space.
2. Exhibitors are required to participate both days. Early breakdown is not permitted. There will be no refunds due to inclement weather. Outdoor exhibitors should be prepared if weather becomes inclement.
3. No pets are allowed in the exhibit grounds. No alcoholic beverages. No profane language or lewd or vulgar conduct will be tolerated.
4. Exhibitors are responsible for collecting and paying Georgia Sales Tax. A tax form will be provided.
5. The applicant hereby agrees to defend, indemnify and hold harmless Georgia Horse Council, Southern States and the Georgia National Fairgrounds and Agricenter, their officers, agents, successors and assigns from and against any and all claims, demands, actions or causes of actions, suits at law or inequity of any nature or character arising out of or by reason of any act or omission of the second party or its agents in the performance of the rights, duties, and obligations of the second party under this agreement. The second party understands that Georgia Horse Council assumes no responsibility or liability for any property of the second party, which may be located on the above described premises. For and in consideration of permission to participate in Triple Crown Super Show Barrel Race the specified above shall be subject to acts of God or any condition or circumstances beyond the control of Georgia Horse Council which shall prevent the carrying out of some or all of Georgia Horse Council, upon the occurrence of such event, shall have the right to terminate this agreement without liability of any nature.
6. Exhibitors may not tape signs to walls or pillars or hang from ceilings; nor may they place chairs, signs or easels in the aisles.
7. Exhibitors shall not damage or deface equipment, walls or flooring of the exhibit space. If such damage occurs, the exhibitor is liable to the owner of the damaged property.
