

The Georgia Horse Council will be having an Open Mounted Drill Team Competition February 18, 2012 at the Southeastern Arena in Unadilla, Georgia. Attached you will find the entry forms, release forms and rules for the event. If you have not already, you will need to purchase the United States Equestrian Drill Association (USEDA) manual in order to have ALL the rules for each class. Please go to <http://useda.us> to order your manual. **IMPORTANT: please make sure to read the Misc. Rules as we have some new and important news!!! We will only be having one (1) USED A show and that will be our last show which is the State and Region 7 show.**

Registration and check-in will begin at 1:00 PM on Friday, February 17. Absolutely no check-in will take place before 1:00 PM. If you arrive early, you are welcome to keep your horse tied to your trailer until check-in. Please be sure and bring your current negative Coggins certificates. They will be checked at registration. Music and introduction must be turned in by 9 PM Friday night (no exceptions). ***You should have a separate CD and write-up per class you are entering and they should be in separate envelopes. Do not combine everything into one CD and one write-up.*** Introduction must be typed and double spaced (no hand written introductions will be accepted, 3 points will be deducted from your score if introduction is not typed). If not turned in by 9PM, your team will be penalized 3 points. An announcer will be available. We will allow one person from the team to be present in the announcer booth during the introduction to your team. There will be no Opening Ceremony and the show will start at 8:00AM sharp with the Judges meeting at 7:15 AM.

Entry Forms: please fill out a separate entry form for each team you have. For example: if you have a Floyd County JV and a Floyd County V, you will need a form for each one. Please do not combine all your teams onto one entry form. Make sure you have all signatures on the release forms and the entry form. If all signatures are not on the form (especially the County Agent) you will not be allowed to participate. If you do not send your release forms back with your entries, you will need to bring them with you to the show or you will not be allowed to participate. Make sure that you collect all money especially for RV parking. It is the responsibility of each Coach to make sure parents reserve their RV spot with them and pay the Coach. I will no longer accept checks from visitors that did not reserve their RV parking through the coach. I will only accept cash so please collect the money from your parents and/or grandparents or anyone visiting a participant. **Cannot compete until all bills are paid (RV, stalls, entry, etc.).**

Late Entries: If entries are received after the deadline, there will be a \$50.00 late fee and you will be responsible for any postage due for awards. Please do not request sending entries late. I cannot get awards ordered and here on time for the shows if the entry deadline is not met and I cannot afford to pay postage for awards. These kids deserve to get their awards at the competition not 3-4 weeks after the competition.

We Accept Checks Only. Check Policy: for your convenience, if your check is dishonored or returned for any reason, we will electronically debit your account for the amount of the check plus a processing fee of \$30.00
